The most important for your packing list



When packing for a motorhome, the rule is: as much as necessary, as little as possible. Our packing list covers all important areas – divided into **essential equipment**, **comfort equipment**, and **technology & accessories**. So nothing is missing on the road.


Essential equipment

Before the trip

- ID card / Passport
- Driver's license
(national + international if applicable)
- Visas (depending on the destination)
- Foreign travel coverage / Breakdown cover
- Green insurance card
- Medication & prescriptions
- Vaccinations / Certificates
(depending on the destination)
- Tires / Lights / Fluids checked
- Gas checked
- Onboard systems checked
(power, water, heating, refrigerator)
- Pitches / Campsites reserved
- Ferries booked
- Tolls / Vignettes organized

Documents

- Vehicle registration certificate
- Proof of insurance
- Gas inspection certificate
- Booking confirmations
(campsites, ferries, tickets)
- Toll documents / Parking discs /
Vignette receipts
- International health insurance
- Vaccination record
- Medication plan
- Credit card / Debit card
- Cash (including coins)

 Collect all documents in a small folder and stow it within easy reach (e.g., glove compartment / side pocket).

Vehicle & Safety

- Warning triangle
- High-visibility vests (one per seat)
- First-aid kit
- Spare bulbs
- Spare fuses
- Vehicle keys
- Spare gas bottle
- Leveling wedges / Wheel chocks
- Fire extinguisher / Fire extinguishing spray
- Fire blanket (optional)
- Gas detector
- CO detector
- Steering wheel or pedal lock
- Warning sign (for overhanging loads)

Traveling with Children

Child seat / Infant carrier
Travel cot / Bed guard
Cuddly blanket / Favorite stuffed toy
Water bottles

Wet wipes

(outfit + rain / mud clothing if needed)
Games / Books / Coloring supplies

 Pack a "stop bag" (snacks, wet wipes, 1 spare outfit) – keep it in the front, and it saves a huge amount of time during breaks.

Traveling with a Dog

Leash (short + long lead if needed)
Collar / Harness
Poop bags
Dog food
Bowl (ideally foldable)
Water bottle

Dog blanket / Sleeping area
Towel
Tick remover
Medication / First-aid kit (for dogs)
EU pet passport / Vaccination record (including rabies)
Microchip proof (depending on the destination)
